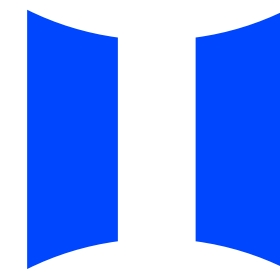

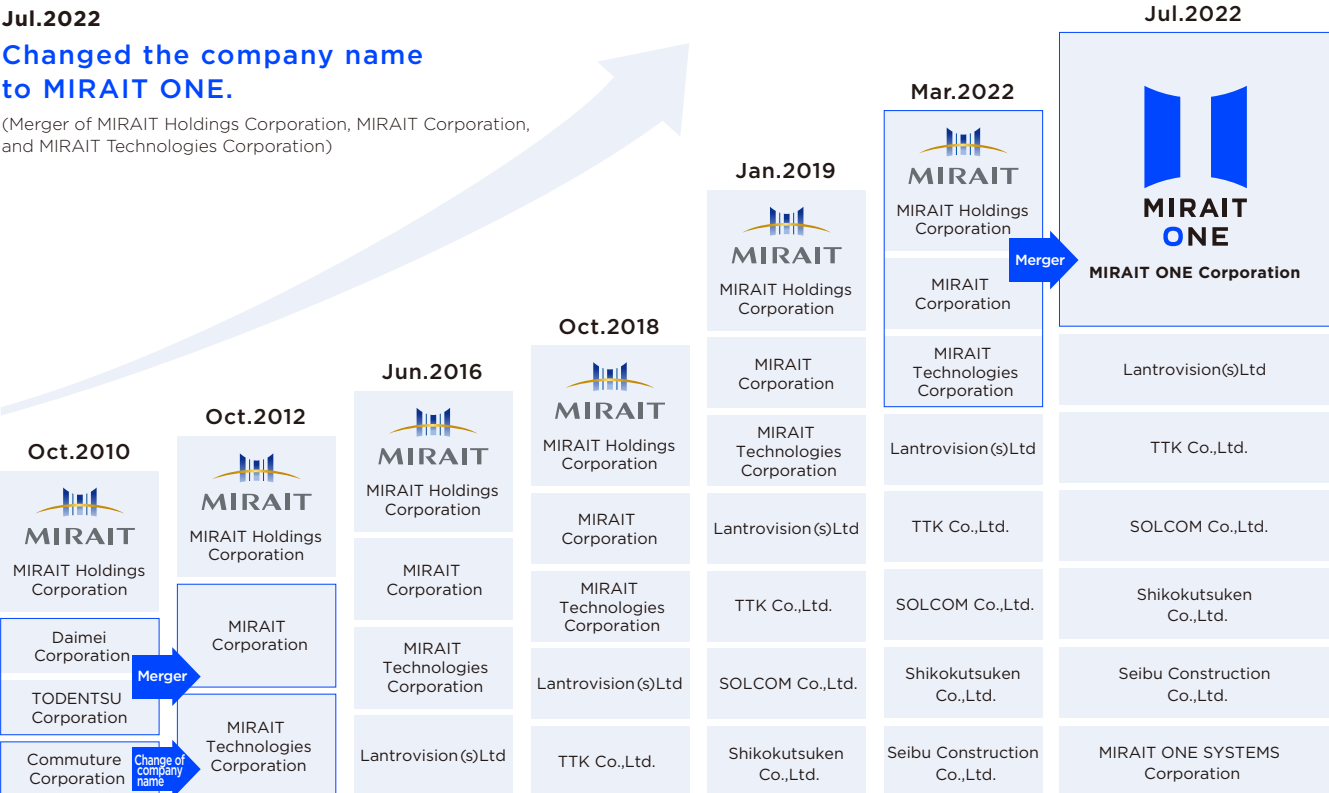
After the business merger in July 2022, the MIRAITS ONE Group reconfirmed that its purpose is "Co-creating an exciting future through challenges and technology."
